

## BYLAW REVISION VOTE

In the interest of clarity and consistency, the elders of Crossroads are recommending a statement reflecting our commitment to biblical marriage be added to our Church bylaws. Any change in the bylaws requires an affirmation of the membership which will occur following the services on Sunday, May 15. The elders are only recommending one change to the bylaws at this time, the addition of the following paragraph:

### ***Statement on Marriage and Sexuality***

*As first described in Genesis and later affirmed by Jesus (Matthew 19:4-6), marriage is a God-ordained, covenant relationship between a man and a woman. This lifelong, sexually exclusive union brings children into the world and thus sustains the stewardship of the earth. Biblical marriage – marked by faithfulness, sacrificial love and joy – displays the relationship between God and his people (Ephesians 5:32). Any sexual activity outside of biblical marriage is contrary to God's will and design (1 Corinthians 6:18-20). This includes sexual activity before marriage, between members of the same gender, with multiple partners, or outside of the species. Crossroads Evangelical Church is committed to upholding biblical marriage within our membership and advocating biblical marriage within our culture.*

This affirmation will be for members only immediately following the services on May 15. If you are a member, please read this statement carefully and be prepared to respond on May 15<sup>th</sup>. If you have any questions please feel free to contact Pastor Matt or any of the elders. Thank you.

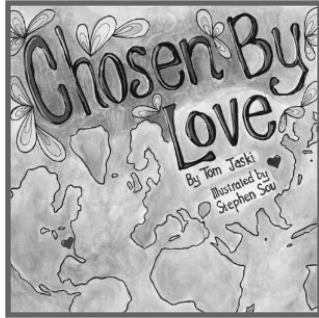
## MORE NEW LIBRARY ITEMS

#### Chosen By Love

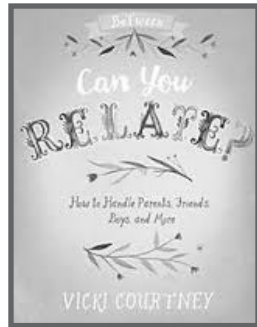

### RELAY FOR LIFE USED BOOK SALE

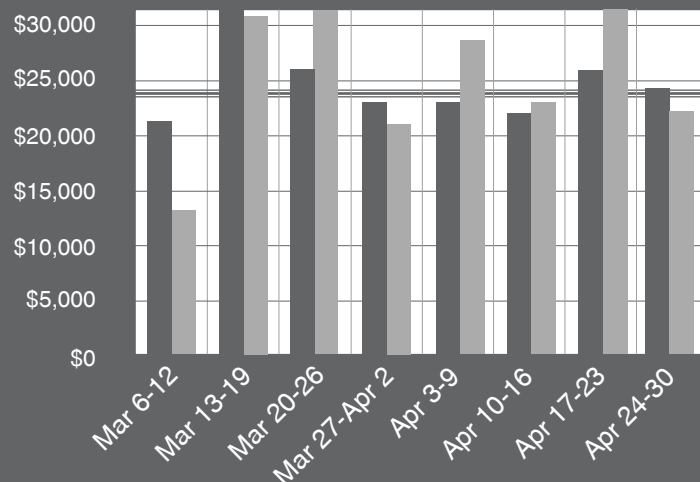
