### DOUBLE RED BLOOD DRIVE


Every 2 seconds someone in the United States needs blood. Without the donations of over 9.2 million blood donors, those needs would not be met. The American Red Cross will hold a double-red blood drive in Crossroads' dining room on Tuesday, July 26th from 12:00 noon until 6:00 p.m. A Double Red Cell donation collects twice the red cells of a typical donation, but returns most of the plasma and platelets to the donor. This allows you to help more people each time you donate blood. These donors must meet specific eligibility requirements and have type A Negative, B Negative, or O blood. Call 1-800-RED-CROSS to make an appointment.
